Having been registered as a charity it is now the charity of the High Sheriffs in England and Wales. In 2002 it was launched in North Wales by the High Sheriffs of Clwyd and Gwynedd and it is supported by the North Wales Police and Community Trust (PACT) to help young people to develop projects so as to make their community a safer place in which to live.

## CRIMEBEAT – WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT?

CRIMEBEAT encourages groups of young people aged five to twenty-five to set up a project in their community that will help to prevent crime, reduce crime or improve community safety.

The group should: -

- Identify any problems in their community that can be related to crime or community safety.
- Choose one of the problems identified.
- Find a practical, achievable solution to that problem.
- If there is a cost involved in carrying out the project fill out the application form for funding from Crimebeat.

To qualify for funding of up to a maximum amount of £500 per project the following criteria must be met: -

- If members of the group are aged under eighteen, the group must have the support of an adult. For example a youth worker, teacher or community group leader.
- The project must have a significant element of crime prevention, crime reduction or community safety.
- The members of the group must be actively involved in carrying out the project.
- The project should aim to promote young people as valued members of the community and try to include as many sections of the community as possible.

A selection panel will consider the application, if the criteria are met, Crimebeat will award the funding to the group so that they can put their ideas into action.

Each year Crimebeat will select the project considered to be the most successful and a prize will be awarded to the group. The project will also be considered for a National Crimebeat Award.

There is no closing date for applications but funds are limited so don't delay act today!

## TRECHU TROSEDD – BETH YDY O?

Mae TRECHU TROSEDD yn annog pobl ifanc rhwng pump a phump-ar-hugain mlwydd oed i fynd ati i sefydlu prosiect yn eu cymuned fydd o gymorth i atal trosedd, gostwng trosedd a gwella diogelwch cymunedol.

Dylai'r grŵp:

- Adnabod problemau yn eu cymuned a allai fod yn berthnasol i drosedd neu ddiogelwch cymunedol
- Dewis un o'r problemau a adnabuwyd
- Canfod datrysiad ymarferol, cyraeddadwy i'r broblem
- Os bydd cynnal y prosiect yn golygu costau, llenwi ffurflen gais am arian gan Trechu Trosedd

Er mwyn bod yn gymwys i dderbyn arian hyd at y swm uchaf bosib, sef £500 i bob prosiect, mae'n rhaid diwallu'r meini prawf canlynol:-

- Os oes aelodau o'r grŵp yn iau na deunaw oed, bydd yn rhaid i'r grŵp gael cefnogaeth oedolyn. Er enghraifft, gweithiwr ieuenctid, athro neu arweinydd grŵp cymunedol.
- Mae'n rhaid i'r prosiect gynnwys elfen sylweddol o atal trosedd, gostwng trosedd neu ddiogelwch cymunedol.
- Mae'r rhaid i aelodau'r grŵp gymryd rhan weithredol yn y prosiect.
- Dylai'r prosiect geisio hybu pobl ifanc fel aelodau gwerthfawr o'r gymuned a cheisio cynnwys cymaint o adrannau'r o'r gymdeithas â phosib.

Bydd panel dethol yn ystyried y cais. Os bydd y meini prawf yn cael eu diwallu, bydd Trechu Trosedd yn rhoi arian i'r grŵp i'w galluogi i roi eu syniadau ar waith.

Ar ddiwedd bob blwyddyn bydd y prosiect a ystyrir i fod yn fwyaf llwyddiannus hefyd yn cael gwobr. Bydd y prosiect hefyd yn cael ei ystyried ar gyfer derbyn Gwobr Trechu Trosedd Cenedlaethol.

Ni phennwyd dyddiad cau ar gyfer ceisiadau ond mae nawdd yn gyfyngedig felly gorau bo gyntaf i chi roi eich cais i mewn.
